<p>Since Spalding County has taken responsibility for the Council on Aging scope of services in partnership with Three Rivers Area Agency on Aging, the Senior Center has increased by approximately 100 members. The Senior Nutrition Program is staffed with a nutritionist and office assistant. The new Senior Nutrition Program is located at the Senior Center, 885 Memorial Drive, Griffin, Georgia. In the past, this program was managed by the Council on Aging/Meals On Wheels, the new program combines the existing program with services through the Senior Center to offer nutritional meals, prepared fresh in the on-site kitchen, every day for homebound and on-site patrons. Volunteers are needed for Meals on Wheels. There are 76 on the waiting list.</p>
